2024 National Kolping Scholarship Winners

Once again we are very pleased to announce that the National Kolping Society was able to award scholarships to individuals attending colleges, universities, trade school and high school. These financial awards go a long way in assisting members and their families continue to enrich themselves through education.

This year, we will be awarding 7 college/university level scholarships at \$3,000 each. It is an honor to serve on the scholarship committee and many thanks to Mariliee Uhlhorn, Monika Weiss and Lisa Brinkmann for taking on this program.

We received applications and essays from 16 individuals, representing 6 of our Kolping Families. Our selection/ rating process is completely anonymous to the committee members. 


